## Questions

### 1. L \_\_\_\_\_ to find Jesus.

*“After Jesus was born in Bethlehem in Judea, during the time of King Herod, Magi from the east came to Jerusalem and asked, ‘Where is the one who has been born king of the Jews? We saw his star in the east and have come to worship him.’”*

*Matthew 2:1-2*

### 2. O \_\_\_\_\_ your eyes to truth.

*“When Herod heard this he was disturbed...Then Herod called the Magi secretly and found out from them the exact time the star had appeared. He sent them to Bethlehem and said, ‘Go and make a careful search for the child. As soon as you find him, report to me, so that I too may go and worship him.’”*

*Matthew 2:3, 7-8*

### 3. O \_\_\_\_\_ according to your priorities.

*“When they saw the star, they were overjoyed. On coming to the house they saw the child with his mother Mary, and they bowed down and worshiped him. Then they opened their treasures and presented him with gifts of gold and of incense and of myrrh. And having been warned in a dream not to go back to Herod, they returned to their country by another route.”*

*Matthew 2:10-12*

*“When Herod realized that he had been outwitted by the Magi, he was furious, and he gave orders to kill all the boys in Bethlehem and its vicinity who were two years old and under.”*
