## Questions

### 1. M\_\_\_\_\_ a difference.

*“Now a man of the house of Levi married a Levite woman, and she became pregnant and gave birth to a son. When she saw that he was a fine child, she hid him for three months. But when she could hide him no longer, she got a papyrus basket for him and coated it with tar and pitch. Then she placed the child in it and put among the reeds along the bank of the Nile. His sister stood at a distance to see what would happen to him.”*

### 2. A\_\_\_\_\_ your faith.

*“By faith Moses’ parents hid him for three months after he was born, because they saw he was no ordinary child, and they were not afraid of the king’s edict.”*

*Hebrews 11:23*

*“By faith Moses, when he had grown up, refused to be known as the son of Pharaoh’s daughter. He chose to be mistreated along with the people of God rather than to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a short time...By faith he left Egypt, not fearing the king’s anger; he persevered because he saw him who is invisible.”*
