Getting To Know Each Other

- Can you share a personal experience where you felt God's power working in you, doing more than you could ask or imagine?

Into the Bible

Read Ephesians 3:1-6

- What stands out to you from these verses?
- In the message we heard Bondages have corresponding freedoms, and all freedoms have corresponding bondages... What does this mean to you?
- What does Paul mean when he refers to himself as a prisoner for Christ Jesus?
- How does Paul describe the mystery of Christ in verse 6? How might this relate to us?
- How should our understanding that we receive the promise of Jesus impact our lives and relationships with others (Think of the us and them conversation)?

Read Ephesians 3:7-13

- What stands out from these verses?
- What are your thoughts on Paul's humility as the least of all the Lord's people?
- What is the church's responsibility today in revealing God's wisdom to the world (Look at verse 10 for reference)?
- What should our response as believers be according to verses 11-12?
- How can we take the truths of God's grace, the church's role, and access to God in our lives and ministry?

Read Ephesians 3:14-21

- What stand out from these verses?
- What does Paul ask God for in verse 16? Why is this request significant for spiritual lives?
- What does it mean for Christ to dwell in our hearts, and how does it impact our daily lives?
- According to verse 20, how should this encourage our faith and prayer life?
